

FACT SHEET



Danger-

Check for danger to Yourself, the Patient and Bystanders

Response-

Check for response by Talk and Touch

Send for help-

If unresponsive send for help by calling Triple Zero (000)

Airway-

Open airway and ensure it is clear. If not roll patient on their side and clear the airway

Breathing-

Check breathing. If the patient is not breathing or the breathing is Not Normal commence CPR CPR-

Start CPR

Give 30 chest compressions followed by 2 rescue breaths.

Defibrillation-

Attach Automatic External Defibrillator (AED) as soon as possible and follow its prompts.

Further Information

 If unable or unwilling to conduct breathing then continue with chest compressions only.
