# **Poisoning**

#### 1. Follow DRSABCD

• Call fire brigade if atmosphere contaminated with smoke or gas

### **Unconscious patient**

· Monitor airway and breathing

## **Conscious patient**

- Listen to patient and give reassurance
- Try to determine type of poison taken
- Call 13 11 26 for Poisons Information Centre and follow their instructions
- 2. Send any vomit, containers and evidence with patient to hospital

DO NOT induce vomiting unless advised to do so by Poisons Information Centre.

DO NOT give anything by mouth unless advised to do so by the Poisons Information Centre Wash substances off mouth and face with fresh water.
