

FACT SHEET



Spider Bite

- 1. Follow DRSABCD
- 2. Lie patient down
- 3. Calm and reassure patient
- 4. Apply management for

Funnel-web / Mouse spider

- If on a limb, apply a broad pressure bandage over the bite site as soon as possible
- Apply a firm pressure immobilization bandage starting just above fingers or toes and as far up limb as possible
- Ensure patient does not move
- Ensure an ambulance has been called on Triple Zero (000)

Red-back spider

- Apply cold pack/compress to area to lessen pain
- · Seek medical aid promptly

Other spider bites

- · Wash with soap and water
- Apply icepack to relieve the pain/discomfort
- Seek medical aid if patient develops severe
